### The Fun

Trinity's Stewardship Team, energized by the wonderful church family dinners we hosted last January and again in September, invites YOU to an "Olde-Fashioned Sunday Dinner" on Sunday, January 27!

We will celebrate the meal together following our Pledge Celebration Sunday service that morning at 10:30 – that's right! We'll all worship together in one service and then enjoy a delicious Sunday Dinner together.

Trinity will provide the chicken – cooked in several of your favorite ways – and YOU bring the blue-ribbon sides – salads, vegetables, desserts.

# The Facts – Operating Budget

On October 30, the Church Council approved the 2013 Budget as proposed by the Finance Team of \$1,637,046. For Trinity to have a fully balanced budget, we will need an additional \$132,000 in congregational pledges over 2012 giving levels. Trinity is extremely blessed to have had members with financial foresight, who created trust accounts that now serve to supplement our personal stewardship!

And over this last year, in addition to our pledged, budgeted giving, more than \$70,000 were generously contributed for designated outreaches such as; Hope Community's renovation, the Clothing Connection, the Guatemala mission trip, and for our sister church in Fomento, Cuba!

Trinity also participates with other United Methodist churches in Florida with budgeted giving in excess of \$152,000; we budget for local community agencies that serve the needy here Tallahassee, such as The Shelter, Hope Community, and Neighborhood Health Center. Internationally, we support a mission base in Guatemala, and world and youth mission trips.



All told, this outreach and mission giving makes up 13% of our budget. We hope this illustrates that our church has a commitment to tithe from our own budget, as we encourage our members to tithe from their incomes ... we cannot ask our members to do something that we would not do as a church!

The 2013 Budget includes funding for the SPRC recommendation of a 2% acrossthe-board pay raise for church staff. In fact, they insisted that Rev. Curry accept their mandate; he has not accepted a raise since his tenure at Trinity began in 2008!



Trinity makes generous employer contributions to eligible employee's UMC 403b plans and pays for health insurance for full-time workers. It is a well-known fact that health insurance premiums have sky-rocketed and our provider is no exception. These items account for the increase in payroll expenses for 2013.

# The Facts – Capital Budget

This year, our proposed capital budget is about twice what it has been in previous years. We have been blessed over the last few years to have been the beneficiary of several members' estates. Those funds have been used for many of the projects and updates that have occurred over the last five years. Prior to that time, our capital budget was regularly set annually at \$100,000. Your Trustees Team has been very, very careful with these funds and has only requested \$30,000 the last few years.

This year, however, we have a major safety issue that must be rectified. Our current fire alarm system is more than 25 years old – at this juncture, we cannot buy parts to repair it anymore – it must be replaced. If this current system were to fail, we would have to close Trinity's Preschool and would likely sustain significant damage. The Trustees will be budgeting an additional \$33,000 for each of the next five years, to make payments on a low-interest loan/line of credit to purchase this system and other long-range cost saving improvements.

Rev. Curry will be having a number of "Let's Talk" sessions throughout the month detailing the budget and answering any questions you may have.
