Dear Jack,

Have received your letter, also two bulletins to-date. I thank very much for both. I like your Service Bulletin and know the rest of the church members do also, especially those in the Service.

I have now been in the Army four months and although I miss home very, very much, the Army has good features in it and there are some parts of it you really enjoy.

I'm attending Army Administration school here at the Calavado State A & M and upon graduating will get a 10 day furlough-- that's what I'm looking forward to, and in a big way.

The people here are very cordial and especially so at church. I have been to hear the Chaplain several times but for some reason had rather get out and go into town to church whenever possible.

Yes, my work at the PX was very confining. It prevented me from attending services and that was the one thing I did not like about my job. I'm trusting that in the not too distant future, we may again settle down to our normal selves. Until then, I hope to quickly get some kind of rating whereby I can let Evelyn come to me. She's one of those (hard) Baptists--remember?
