Dear Sir:

I am taking the liberty of writing to you because I am a member of the Methodist Church and have faith in its ministers and congregation.

I want to bring my baby & come to Tallahassee to live so I can be near my husband for the few months before he leaves. Then I want to stay there after he goes as I really have no real home. My parents are old & live with my married sister - conditions are unsuitable for the baby - I am now living with my in-laws and they are old and I am unwanted there as

the baby upsets their routine.

I would much prefer to live alone and later on when my second sister's husband is sent overseas, she is coming to live with us.

Please tell me if it is unwise to come there, if it is too crowded. If you have the time & the inclination, perhaps you could locate a one bedroom furnished apartment (1st floor) for me about \$45-55 a month.

It is so hard for us here, the baby is becoming nervous & spoiled from being scolded & prevented from normal activities.

I would be greatly indebted to you.
