From the Bulletin it seems that most of Tallahassee is here in England. Everyday I look for a familiar face. You asked for each of us to drop you a line

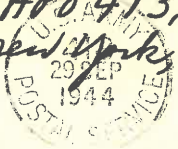
once every three months at least. Well, since so many of us are here in England you probably have heard all about the country, people and things but if I can run across something a little less likely to have already been told, I'll write to you.
