I am still flying as a tail gunner and, am getting along just fine. I really enjoy receiving the Bulletin now more than ever. Since all the letters from home do not include everything.

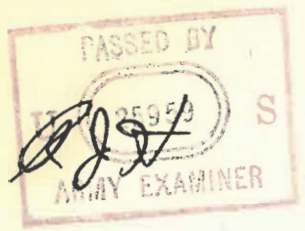
Since I have been in the Pacific I have not had the pleasure of seeing any one from Tally. but, I have run into several fellows from Fla.
