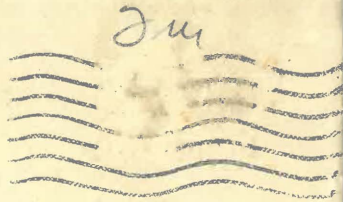
Attending religious services is not compulsory but one 'just does'.
