all the people I know.

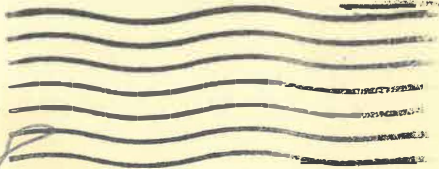
I am going to be
